EXAMPLES OF WORK:

Positions in the class perform processing & beneficial reuse, through agricultural land application, of waste water plant residuals under strict environmental regulation. Class contains trainee positions where incumbents are expected to achieve required certifications. Operates belt press, sludge de-watering equipment at a municipal waste water treatment plant, treats using lime stabilization process, at proper dehydration loads into dump truck, safely transports to designated sites and applies using spray, spreading, chopping equipment as per instructions and guidelines. Takes samples, measures acidity, adds lime as necessary to assure heavy metals are not leached. Makes minor repairs and adjustments on belt press, pumps, wash down and sanitation equipment. Performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

High School diploma or equivalent supplemented by experience necessary to become proficient operating and maintaining variety of equipment used in sludge treatment and land application is desired. At least a valid drivers license required to test and must obtain a valid Louisiana commercial driver's license Class A with air brake endorsement within 45 days of appointment. Must pass the civil service exam, post-offer drug screen, physical, and functional pre-placement testing. Must be a qualified registered voter; verification must accompany application.

Essential Functions: Lifting up to 52 pounds, climbing, manual dexterity and strength sufficient to operate and maintain plant and automotive equipment are essential, as are vision of at least 20/40 in each eye and depth perception of 80 seconds of arc or better; hearing, mobility and agility within normal limits.

Benefits offered: Paid employee's hospitalization, paid holidays, annual leave, sick leave, and retirement.
