My paintings, which I submit for judging, sale, and exhibition, must be priced with a retail price commensurate with my normal pricing. A 30% commission on works sold will be retained by the City of New Iberia and all sales will be handled by representatives of the Teche Plein Air Committee. Images of work that I enter in the competition, as well as "action" images taken in the field, may be used by the same organization for publicity purposes. All reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure the safety and careful handling of the artwork. However, I recognize that I alone am responsible for the safety of my artwork. A \$45 non-refundable application fee is due at the time of application. Artists juried into the competition will not pay an additional fee to compete. Teche Plein Air committee reserves the right to disqualify works deemed objectionable. We also reserve the right to disqualify any entry that does not adhere to the rules and guidelines of the contest. All decisions of the Teche Plein Air committee are considered final.
