EXAMPLES OF WORK:

Positions operate, depending on area of assignment, street sweepers and heavy mowing and tractor with more complex attached grounds maintenance / mowing equipment, necessary to maintain rights of ways, embankments, as well as assisting with or operating any other equipment assigned, as well as participating in labor work as needed. Inspects equipment before and during the work day. Drives unit to work site, sets up machine, mowers and attachments, explains intended actions to other workers present. Safely operates heavy, slow moving street sweepers and tractors with side boom in and around traffic. Instructs helper in preparing, finishing work site and with machinery, may participate in installing shoring as needed, repairing leaks, pavements, forms, in mowing and trimming. Assists in training workers to perform more responsible tasks, including equipment operation. Performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Literacy and at least a valid Louisiana driver's license (Class D) are required. Must also meet the general requirements of the City's auto insurance company. Prior experience sufficient to enable safe and efficient operations of respective equipment are desired.
- Must pass the civil service exam, post-offer drug screen, physical, and functional pre-placement testing.
- Must be a qualified registered voter; verification must accompany application.

Essential Functions: Prolonged periods of concentration and coordination operating machinery requiring manual dexterity; strength; vision of at least 20/40 in each eye and depth perception of 80 seconds or arc or better; hearing and speaking abilities within normal limits; and ability to engage in heavy lifting of up to 100 lbs., climbing, digging, exertion, and working in confined spaces are required by positions in this class.

Benefits offered: Hospitalization, paid holidays, annual leave, sick leave, and retirement.
