

## Current Local Tax Payment Deadlines

City of New Iberia taxes are collected throughout the year by the City's Tax Office. The collection dates for various City taxes are as follows:

December 31st - personal property tax due for the City of New Iberia business owners

December 31st - real estate property tax due for all real estate owners with property located within the City limits.

Other due dates of interest for taxpayers in the City of New Iberia:

April 15th - federal income tax due

May 15th - state income tax due

20th of each month - sales and use tax returns

If any deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, the due date is generally the next working date. ## Current Local Tax Rates

The real estate property tax rate is 21.57 mills per \$1,000 of assessed value and is payable by all citizens who own real property, such as land or a home, within the city limits of New Iberia.

The personal property tax rate is also 21.57 mills per \$1,000 of assessed value of certain personal goods, including, but not limited to, inventory, furniture and fixtures, equipment, etc. which are owned by anyone doing business in the City of New Iberia, and is payable by the business/owner.

**The sales and use tax rate for the City of New Iberia is 9.45% within the original city limits of New Iberia, which includes a state sales tax rate of 4.45%, Iberia Parish School Board Tax 2%, New Iberia Public Safety Tax .50%, Iberia Parish Mosquito Control .25%, Economic Development .25% and other City of New Iberia tax of 2%.**

**These taxes are levied on taxable goods sold in the City of New Iberia. **Other special taxes include:**

**Hotel/Motel lodging tax of 4% in addition to the standard 9.45% sales tax rate**

**Recreation Tax of .25% within the Hwy 182 Annexation in addition to the standard 9.45% sales tax rate**

**Highway 14 TIF District area of .50% plus the recreation tax of .25% in addition to the 9.45 standard sales tax rate**

Local Tax Licenses

The Sales Tax Department of the Iberia Parish School Board is the central reporting and collecting agency for all sales and use taxes for Iberia Parish. All retail sellers and lessors of tangible personal property and some services must register with the Iberia Parish School Board, Sales Tax Department and collect sales and use tax on business transactions within Iberia Parish. Business are required to report sales figures and remit all sales and use taxes for all agencies within Iberia Parish to the Sales Tax Department of the Iberia Parish School Board.

In addition to the sales and use tax reporting, businesses are required to obtain an Occupational License from the City of New Iberia, if the business has any transactions in the City. Other licenses may be required for certain businesses before operating in New Iberia, including, but not limited to, chain stores, taxies, ambulance companies, wholesale dealers, alcohol and beer distributors, resellers, hotels and motels.
